



Extended Essay OR Reflective Project

Extended Essay

- Research project (on student's own time) "extending" a student's knowledge of IB course work
- \circ 4,000-word essay + reflections



Reflective Project

- O Research project on an <u>ethical</u>
 <u>dilemma</u> connected to student's
 career-related study
- 3,000-word essay + 1,000-word reflection



Service Learning



IBDP CAS (Creativity, Activity, Service)

- Approximately 150 hours of experiences balanced across Creativity, Activity and Service hours
- Documented with reflections and evidence

IBCP Service Learning

- 50 Service Learning hours
- Documented with reflections and evidence


